Dear Parents of the Mukwonago School District:

The Mukwonago Area School District is one of 67 proud school districts across the nation to be awarded the Carol M. White Physical Education Program (PEP) Grant. The U.S. Department of Education has funded the PEP Grant to implement comprehensive, standards-based, integrated physical activity and nutrition programs in schools. Through these programs, it is expected that students will develop an appreciation for lifelong, healthy nutrition and physical fitness habits.

The PEP Program goals for the Mukwonago Area School District (MASD MOVES Project) include the following components:

1. Improve the quality of the MASD physical education curriculum by aligning it with the National Association for Sport and Physical Education and Wisconsin State Standards in physical education.
2. Provide staff professional development in the area of physical education and nutrition.
3. Provide common assessment of student's progress K-12 that documents student proficiency in identified fitness and motor skills.
4. Improve health-enhancing fitness through regular testing, monitored fitness plans, and individualized goal setting. Students will be evaluated using the FITNESSGRAM assessment (height and weight will be taken for metabolic calculations), Three Day Physical Activity Recall (3DPAR), and physical fitness logs.
5. Link the MASD physical education department and MASD food services department with common goals developed during staff development, including nutrition guidelines that will follow the USDA Healthier US School Challenge. Students will take a nutrition survey on fruit and vegetable consumption, a small portion of the Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS).
6. Establish an MASD Wellness Committee to include community members, teachers, and administrators and meet monthly to evaluate PEP Grant program goals.

As part of the PEP Grant guidelines, we must document the activities supported through grant money. This includes submission of Government Performance and Records Act (GPRA) data to the Department of Education in the form of overall statistics (no names will be included). If you have any questions about the MASD MOVES Project, or wish to opt out your child from the PEP Grant Program GRPRA reporting, please complete and sign the back of this letter and return it to your child's school office by Monday, September 29, 2014.
